3. INFRASTRUCTURE

11. FUNCTIONING OF THE COMMITTEES

The following committees were formed and actively engaged for the betterment of students.

Admission Committee

Ananda College distributed 361 UG and 37 PG applications. We admitted 224 UG students and 28 PG students during this academic year.

IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell)

IQAC at Ananda involved itself in collecting data on all academic activities through the MIS software on the college website. IQAC documented all the common activities of the college with geo-tagged photographs.

- NIRF – Our college uploaded the required data on the NIRF website.
- IQAC convened two meetings every month to monitor and follow up on the academic activities of the year.
- IQAC successfully uploaded the AQAR and got it approved from the NAAC portal, with the help of the MIS software.
- A Spiritual Animation was organized for the teaching and non-teaching faculty members on 15.03.2025. The programme was handled by Rev. Dr. Kumar Raja.
- The Indian Knowledge System & Incubation Centre was initiated for the betterment of the students. The Indian Knowledge System fostered innovation by integrating traditional wisdom with modern technologies, and the Incubation Centre served as a hub to nurture and support these innovative ideas into successful ventures.

Examination Cell

- Conducting internal assessment tests was one of the main objectives of this committee. Thanks to careful and systematic arrangements, each department successfully conducted the CIA tests.
- It also conducted semester examinations in a successful manner by following the rules and regulations of Alagappa University, Karaikudi.
- It also addressed students' grievances with the University, if any.

Career Guidance & Placement Cell

- The Placement Cell of the college aimed at providing career guidance, counselling, training, and placement.
- Even though students were involved in various academic activities, the Career Guidance & Placement Cell conducted a one-day orientation program on *Mapping Your Ideal Career Path*:

Techniques for Achieving Success, and an orientation program on *Internship Opportunities in Cyber Security* for the betterment of students.

- The Career Guidance & Placement Cell organized a Mock Interview session to help students or job seekers enhance their interview skills and boost their confidence before facing real-world job opportunities. During the session, participants underwent a simulated interview conducted by industry professionals or trained mentors. This exercise aimed to replicate the interview environment, allowing candidates to practice their responses, improve their body language, and receive constructive feedback. The mock interview served as a valuable tool in identifying strengths and areas for improvement, ultimately preparing participants for actual interviews and increasing their chances of securing employment.
- 98 students successfully secured placements with renowned companies such as Wise, Yazaki, and MRF through the efforts of the Career Guidance & Placement Cell. These organizations were well-known for offering excellent career opportunities, and the placements highlighted the effectiveness of the cell's initiatives in preparing students for the job market. Through mock interviews, skill development programs, and industry interactions, students were equipped with the necessary tools to succeed in competitive recruitment processes, ensuring their successful transition from academics to professional careers.

Campus Ministry:

Entrepreneurship Development:

The cell organized various programs, workshops, and activities aimed at nurturing creativity, innovation, and leadership qualities. Recently, the EDC organized two important events for the betterment of students.

The first session, held on 5th February 2025, was handled by G. Subramanian, Income Tax Officer, and M. Intellectual Property Rights:

Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) are legal protections granted to creators, inventors, and businesses for their unique ideas, inventions, designs, and creations. These rights ensure that individuals and organizations can control the use of their intellectual assets, promoting innovation and creativity while preventing unauthorized use. In line with raising awareness about IPR, a session was conducted on 11th March 2025, handled by Mrs. K. R. Rahini, Digital Consultant - E-Marketing, titled *IPR Challenges in the Digital Era*. This event focused on the complexities and challenges of protecting intellectual property in today's fast-evolving digital landscape. It explored topics such as copyright infringement, online piracy, and the impact of digital platforms on intellectual property enforcement. The session aimed to educate participants on the importance of safeguarding their digital innovations and navigating the legal frameworks around IPR in the modern world.

Students Appeal and Redressal:

This committee addressed disciplinary issues and also provided regular guidance to students.

Women's Forum and Grievance Committee:

The Women's Forum organized several impactful events and programs aimed at empowering and educating female students on various crucial topics. These initiatives included:

- *International Day of Women in Diplomacy* – Celebrating the achievements and contributions of women in diplomacy and global leadership on 24th June 2024.

12. STUDENT SUPPORT PROGRESSION:

The institution was concerned with students' progression to higher studies and employment. We identified the reasons for poor attainment and planned to implement remedial measures. Sustainable good practices were followed that effectively supported students and facilitated optimal progression. Our institutional provisions facilitated the vertical movement of students from one level of education to the next higher level or toward gainful employment.

Out of 232 graduates, 86 were placed in various companies, and 120 went for higher studies.

Apart from the curriculum, every department offered Certificate, Diploma, and Add-on Courses. Eight Add-on courses were offered by various departments during this academic year.

14. Financial Assistance from the College:
